Biografía

Maleonn estudió arte desde muy temprana edad. “Siempre he tenido muchas imágenes en mi mente desde que era niño. A veces estaban muy claras. No tengo ni idea de dónde venían, tal vez fuera la razón por la que estudié arte desde mi infancia, tengo una imaginación visual prolífica”. Aunque criado por su abuela, la creatividad corría por sus venas. Su madre fue una importante actriz de la televisión en China y su padre fue director de las óperas más importantes de Shangai en los albores de la Revolución Cultural.

Desde el comienzo de su carrera artística Maleonn ha sido galardonado tanto a nivel nacional como internacionalmente. Maleonn ha exhibido su obra en Shangai, Toronto, Singapur, San Francisco, Roma y París. Sus obras han sido expuestas en los museos más importantes como el Museo de Arte de Shangai, el Zendai MoMA en Shanghai, el MOCA de Shangai, así como en la Liu Hai Su Art Museum, el MOCA de Nueva York, el Victoria & Albert Museum de Londres, The DeVos Art Museum of Michigan o el Museo de Fotografía Contemporánea de Chicago. Por eso decir que Maleonn es un fotógrafo con talento definitivamente no es suficiente. Maleonn también es un diseñador de teatro escénico, un escultor de escenas, un poeta visual y un pintor de emociones.
